

Since 2008, the Greenville-Pitt County Chamber of Commerce's annual Glimpse magazine has served as the official quality of life magazine for the Greenville-Pitt County area. While Greenville and Pitt County have witnessed unprecedented growth over the last 17 years, the mission of Glimpse has remained the same – to showcase Greenville and Pitt County to current and prospective citizens, highlight our progressive business climate, bring hidden gems into the spotlight, and promote the area's burgeoning economy.

The publication first premiered in 2002 as Images of Greenville-Pitt County with the purpose of communicating who we are as a community and promoting our economic strength and growth potential to new businesses. Images of Greenville-Pitt County became Glimpse in 2008, marking the first year the magazine was produced in-house.

To accompany area statistics and demographics, the 2008 magazine highlighted the opening of the East Carolina Heart Institute, the Painted Pirate Project (a partnership of the chamber and the East Carolina Alumni Association), and an overview of the area's sports and recreation attractions. Since that time, each issue of Glimpse has included articles of local interest specific to the Greenville-Pitt County community, with a focus on education, the arts and culture, economic and workforce development initiatives, health care, and community engagement.

Over the years, Glimpse has provided tremendous value to our community by offering a platform to celebrate and market local businesses that drive economic growth and keeping residents informed about developments and opportunities within Pitt County. Glimpse has strengthened connectivity by encouraging partnerships among businesses, organizations, and the broader community – all while positioning Greenville-Pitt County as a vibrant, thriving destination for visitors and potential investors.
